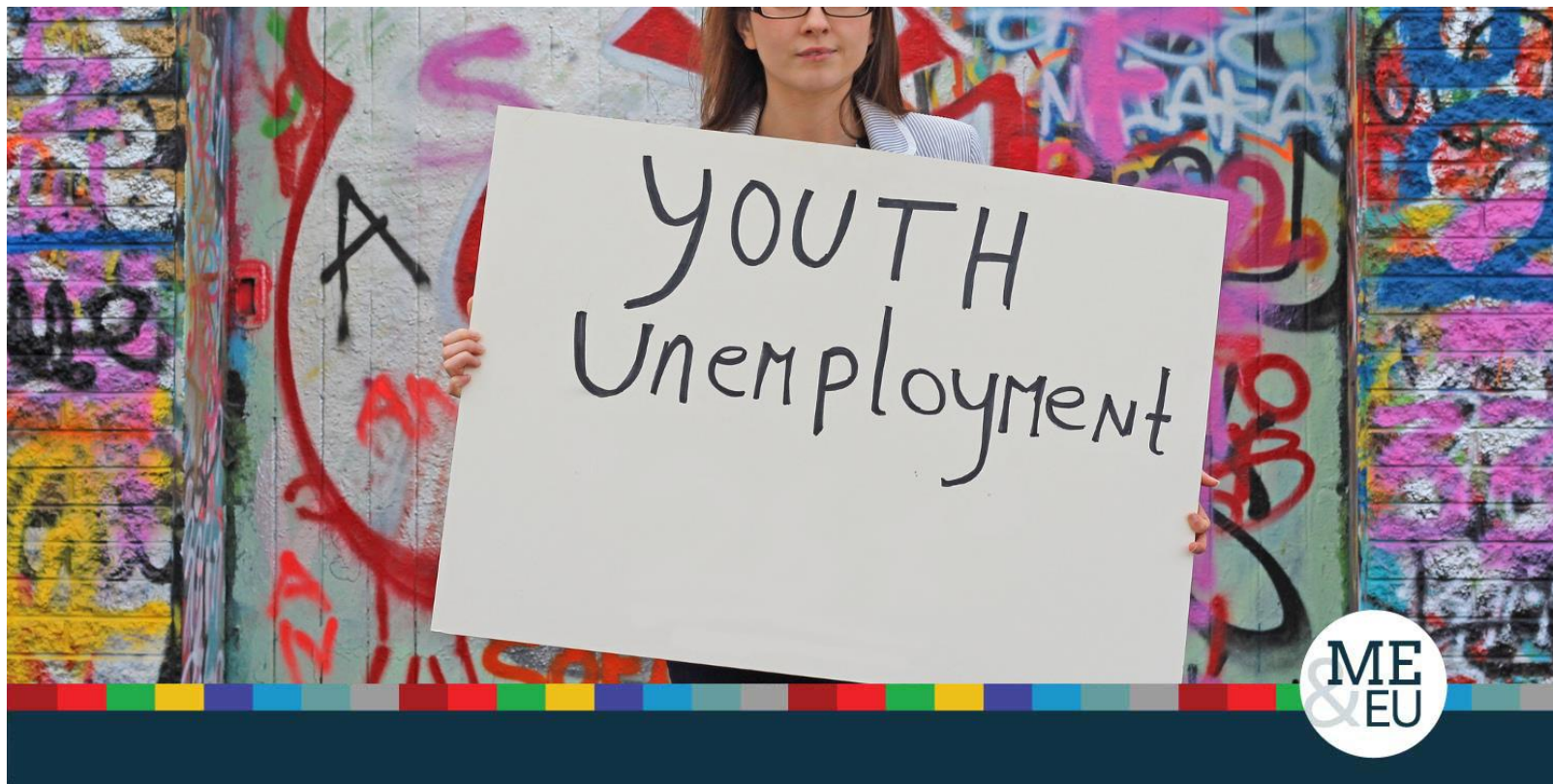

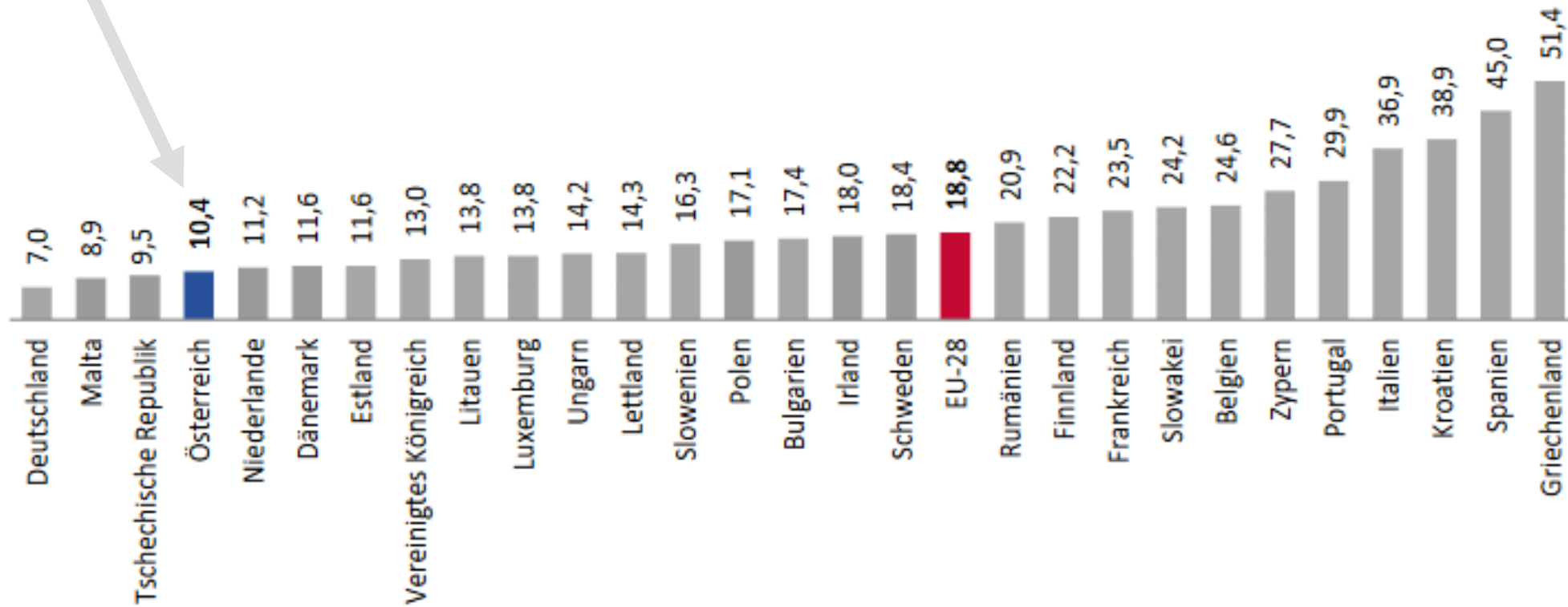
UNEMPLOYMENT IN AUSTRIA

REASONS FOR YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT

- ▶ Low level of education
- ▶ bad economy
- ▶ not enough support for migrants
- ▶ not enough information about professions
- ▶ job market full

MEASURES AGAINST UNEMPLOYMENT

- ▶ investing more money in education
- ▶ leading teenagers into the right direction
- ▶ improving the social coverage
- ▶ work mobility



What to do....

... if I am unemployed

- ▶ registration of unemployment status
- ▶ career plan support at job centers plan
- ▶ job search
- ▶ free training courses



Unemployment benefits

- ▶ must have worked at least 6 months
- ▶ unemployment compensation paid for 6 months
- ▶ afterwards: emergency support (Notstandshilfe)
- ▶ amount depends on prior salary + level of qualification

How teenagers search for jobs

- ▶ write many applications
- ▶ Internships → experience
- ▶ job counselor
- ▶ youth coaches in schools
- ▶ family members

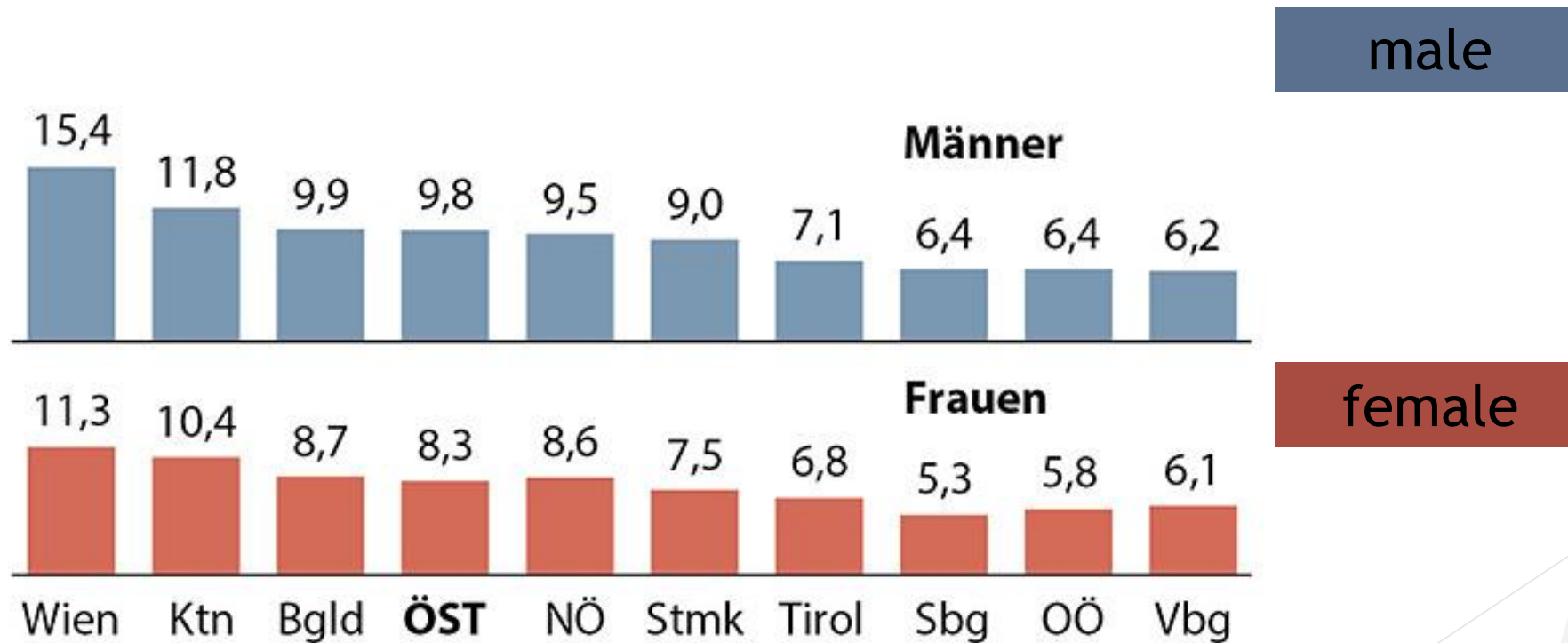

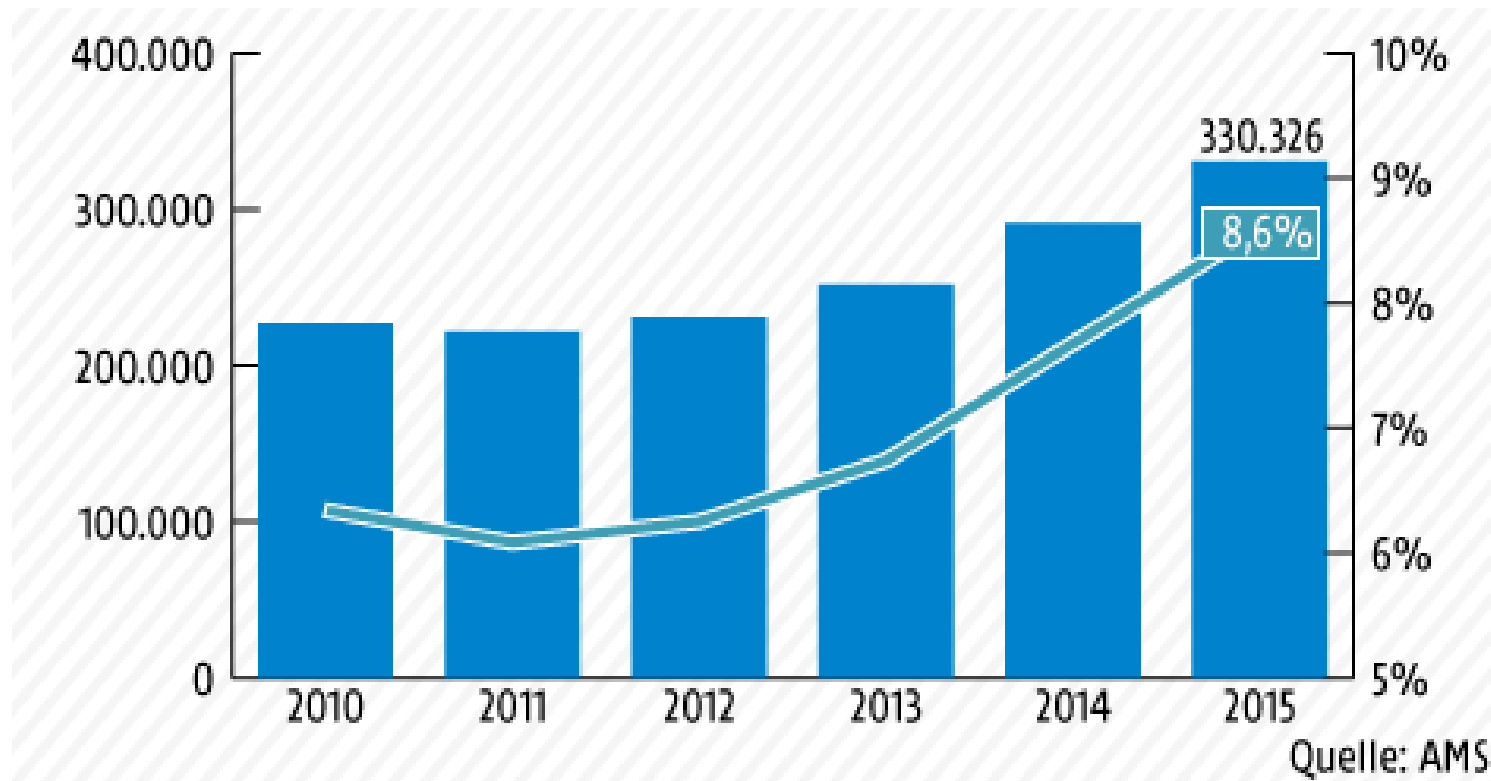
UNEMPLOYMENT IN AUSTRIA 2015

- BY REGION

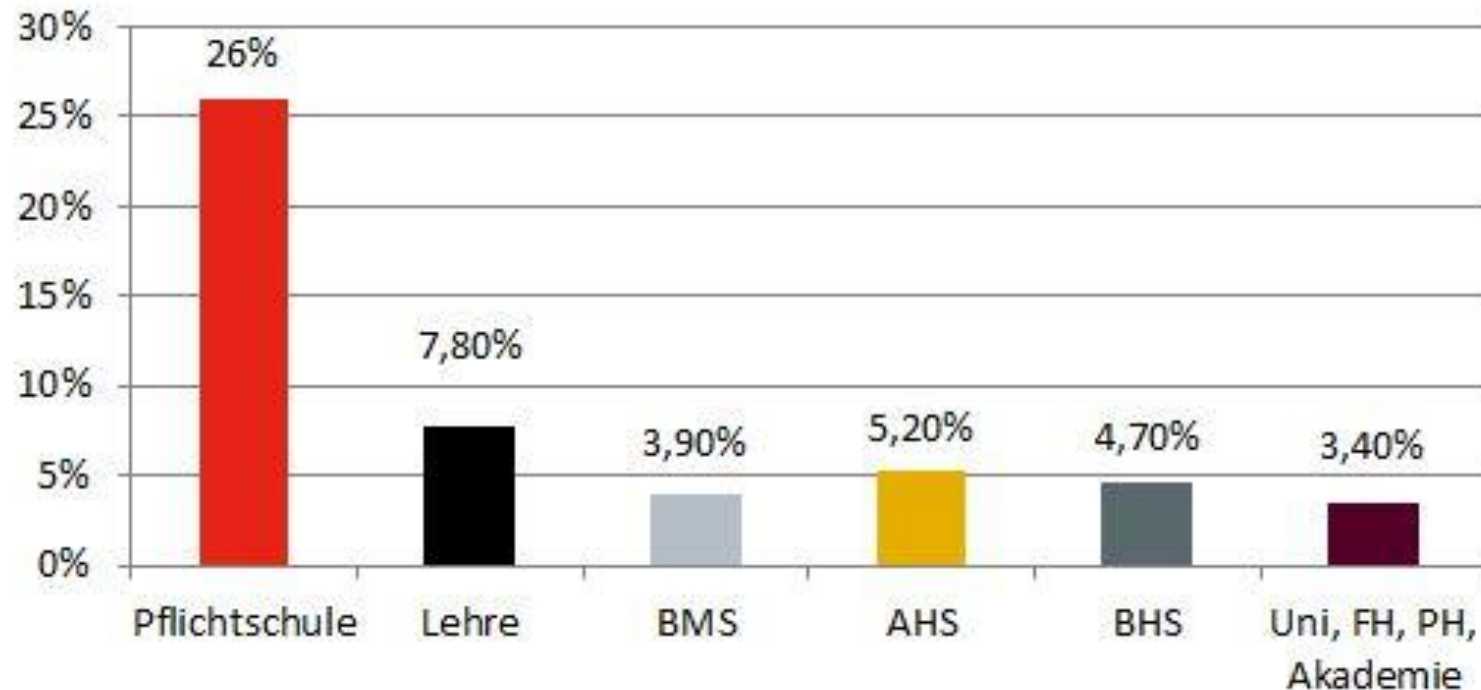


DEVELOPMENT 2010-2015
